Nehemiah Chapter 13: Nehemiah’s final reform

2) Nehemiah took their sin seriously. He SAW what was going on, RESPONDED with action and COMMITTED to God. What steps can we take to be serious about sin in our own lives?

Reflect: Acts 3:19-20; Hebrews 6:19; Psalm 105:4-5; 1 Corinthians 11:28

3) What does it mean to examine ourselves spiritually? What is the role of the church community in these things?

Reflect: Jeremiah 23:29; Proverbs 3:5-6; Colossians 3:16; Proverbs 8:33; 15:32;

4) What does it mean to be a godly person? How did Nehemiah model this?

Reflect: Hebrews 6:10; 1 Corinthians 15:58; Galatians 5:16; Luke 11:7-11; Ephesians 5:18
